Rules, Terms and Conditions:

- Submission can be sent by e-mail by using the new Artisan Competition Form or the Vendors Form but fill in Artisan Competition where it says business name on the Vendors Form.
- Please send the completed entry form with a **product photo**: durhampaganpride@gmail.com. Should your item be accepted, you will receive notification by email. The product photo will be used as part of the event advertising and your business.
- We will take submission day of Pagan Pride but it must be before 1: 30 pm that day.
- Those who submit the day of the competition must fill out an Artisan Competition Information form at the information table.
- **Rules of submission for the items in the contest:**
 - Two items per artisan.
 - Each item must be from a different category i.e., not two wands but one wand and one offering bowl.
 - No alcohol or drug related themes.
 - No bladed items.
 - No sexually explicit themes.
 - No food.
 - No alcohol.
 - No items depicting non-pagan faiths or anti-pagan themes.
 - No items that are racist, sexist, or are disparaging of others.
 - This is a child friendly environment please remember this when entering an item. They should be appropriate to be viewed by all ages.

- DPPD Committee accepts no liability for lost, delayed or misdirected entries nor will be acknowledging receipt of entries. Proof of sending is not proof of receipt. Should your application be accepted, you will receive notification by email.
- All entrants to the DPPD Artisan Competition Awards 2016 agree to take part in reasonable publicity and promotions. This providing product samples for publicity and promotions.
- The winners agree to be available for media interviews and photos upon award announcement.
- Participants must be present and on site with their entries on Durham Pagan Pride Day.
- The decision of the judges is final and no correspondence will be entered into after the competition is over.

Terms:

- It is the sole responsibility of all entrants to provide relevant information to support their entry and all completed entries will become the property of DPPD for the day.
- Participants agree not to hold the organizers responsible in the event of any accident, loss or damage from whatever cause, arising to any article or exhibit or non-delivery of the same.
- Entry to the competition and acceptance of the prize constitutes permission to use any winner's name, image and any competition entry information (excluding contact details except for future customers), for promotional and/or editorial purposes without additional consultation.
- Personal information provided in your entry form will not be passed to any third parties, other than for the purpose of judging the competition or for use as outlined above.
- Winning products may advertise their placement in the competition for a period of three years from the award being given
- By completing an entry form for the DPPD Artisan Competition 2015, you agree to be bound by the above terms and conditions.

Prizes:

- Finalists will be decided by the DPPD Committee.
- There are three prizes: 1st, 2nd and 3rd place which will be decided by public secret ballot.
- All people present that day can vote for their favorite entry; one vote per person.
- Votes will be tallied by two committee members who do not have submissions in the contest.
- A tie for 1st place will be decided by a dice roll from the involved artisans. Highest number wins first position and the second will take 2nd place. This will be the same for 2nd place and for 3rd place the winner gets the 3rd place and the final prize.
- Competition result will be announced at the end of ritual and prizes awarded then.
